## Accomplishments

Medical Management	Low soldier medical readiness required increased time at mobilization for processing or identifying replacements. As Assistant Surgeon General, led a Soldier Medical Readiness Campaign Plan for the Army which improved medical readiness by 5% in the Active Component and 29% in the Reserve Components. Provided solid base for continued improvement.
Resource Management	As Deputy Joint Surgeon for National Guard Bureau, developed Memorandum of Understanding with DHHS utilizing the Economy Act to store/manage medical supplies for National Guard rapid response forces to ensure timely delivery to point of need. Saved over \$500,000 annually.
Collaboration	Reserve component members have limited access to traditional military behavioral health services. While serving as the Joint Surgeon for NGB, worked with DoD, Interagency, and non-governmental organizations to educate civilian behavioral health providers in military culture. Significantly expanded behavioral health access for reserve military members.
Innovation	Disability evaluation system was inefficient for both active and reserve members. As Assistant Surgeon General, developed a Medical Review Board Remote Operating Capability at Camp Atterbury, IN which centralized processing of reserve component board packets. Improved quality, alleviated congestion at MTFs, and reduced processing time by 41%.
Process Improvement	While Indiana State Surgeon and then as Assistant Surgeon General for Quality and Safety worked to establish standardized credentials system in the National Guard and across the entire Army Medical Command. These efforts resulted in improved patient access to care by reducing time to privilege a provider by 39%.
Change Management	New electronic health record system for DoD required phased implementation across the enterprise. While acting as Functional Champion for the Army, worked with Military Health System leadership during the initial roll out of this \$4.3B system to address sequencing of roll-out, standardization, cybersecurity, education, productivity, quality of care, and MTF leadership concerns. Ensured successful implementation across medical treatment facilities for all Services.
